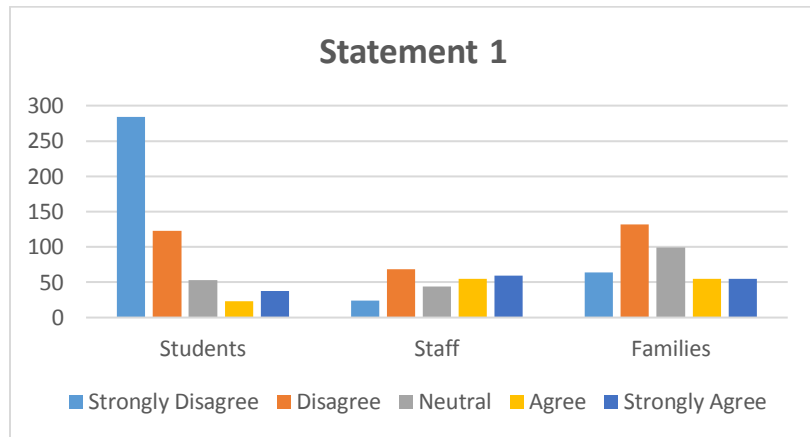
#7 – Cell Phones in Schools

In this survey we wanted to know how you felt about student use of cell phones in schools.

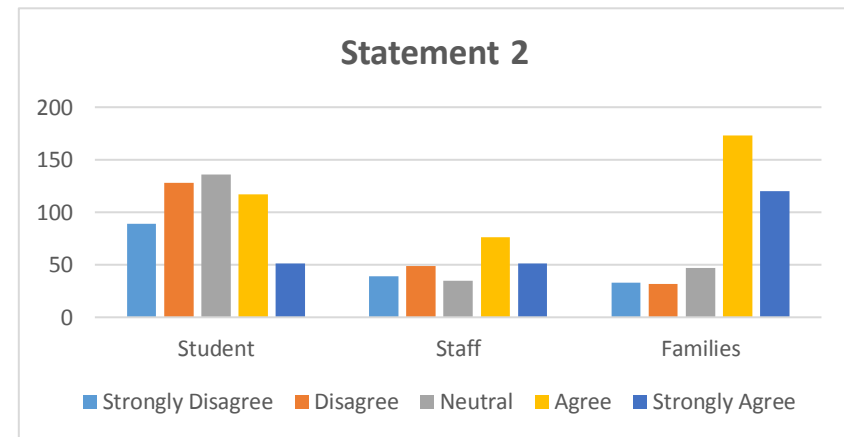
We asked.

Survey Groups: Students, Staff and Families
Respondents: Students – 521;
Staff – 250; Families - 405

Statement 1: Cell phones should not be allowed in School.



Statement 2: Cell phones should be allowed in school, but only used outside of an instructional setting (lunch, recess, between classes, before/after school).



Statement 3: Cell phones should be allowed in school and placed in a secure container when entering the classroom and returned at the end of the class period/day.
