

Question 1: Rank in order of importance from 1 to 5, the following curriculum offerings at Monroe Public Schools.

Science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM)	232	120	23
College classes offered at school, during the school day (for college credit)	195	101	79
Career and Technical Education	144	170	61
Fine arts (art, band, orchestra, vocal music and performing arts)	69	121	185
Leadership	61	116	198
Entrepreneurial Classes	49	122	204

Question 2: How important is it that MPS teaches social and emotional skills like conflict resolution, showing understanding and empathy for others, and being aware of emotions?

Very Important - 68%

Somewhat Important - 20%

Neutral - 8%

Not Important - 4%

Question 3: How important is it to offer alternate settings for the delivery of curriculum such as virtual classrooms or online/blended learning?

Very Important - 34.6% Somewhat Important - 38% Neutral - 20% Not Important - 7%
