What are the
requirements for
NJHS?

Initial selection shall consist of the following criteria:

1. Admissible G.P.A. 3.4 or higher
2. Successful completion of the Student Information Form
3. Typed application essay
4. Two letters of recommendation--one from an educator and one from a non-educator
5. Discipline: student has NOT received in-house or out of school suspensions at Monroe Middle School
6. ALL above required application materials are turned in prior to the deadline

Maintaining membership after being selected:

1. Maintain minimum GPA (3.4)
2. Maintain a positive behavioral record, no in-house or out of school suspensions
3. Must perform four (4) hours of community service per semester
4. 80% attendance rate of National Junior Honor Society meetings, gatherings, service projects, etc. (meetings are held monthly)

When can I
apply for NJHS?

- If you are eligible to apply for NJHS, you will receive a formal invitation to attend an informational meeting on the application process.
- In order to receive an invitation, you **MUST** meet the first criteria, a cumulative 3.4 GPA or higher for the first two quarters at Monroe Middle School.
- Approximately 2-3 weeks after the 2nd quarter ends, invitations will be handed out.
