Monroe Public Schools received an additional instructional time intervention grant in the amount of \$78,120 that can be put towards our K-3 efforts in early literacy.

Board members received information relating to the NSBA Annual Conference. They also received MASB Board of Education Governance Standards. Many boards are reviewing the standards and passing resolutions to adopt these standards as their own.
