## For the November 27, 2018 Board of Education Meeting (#20)

- Additional Instructional Time and Interventions grant: Monroe Public Schools has been awarded an initial grant award of \$74,900.57 for the Additional Instructional Time and Interventions grant. Funding will be used to assist with the cost of additional instructional time to those pupils in grades K-3 who have been identified by using Michigan Department of Education approved screening and diagnostic tools as needing additional supports and interventions in order to be reading at grade level by the end of grade 3. This funding was authorized by Section 35(a)5 of the State School Aid Act, P.A. 265 of 2018.
- Raisinville RoadRunners Robotics: Raisinville Elementary's First Lego
  Robotics Team competed in their first competition on November 17. Their
  robot, Frank, successfully and reliably completed one mission during the
  tournament. All of the programming, design and building of Frank was
  completed by ten 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students. They will be attending the
  December 11 Board of Education meeting to provide you with a
  demonstration of Frank.
- Ward Olsen Custer Elementary Turkey Trot: Also last Saturday our Custer Families were busy with the Ward Olson Turkey Trot.
