- Welcome back! After a restful break, we are finally back to begin a new year of learning and growing in our Monroe Public Schools community.
- Acting in Service for All If you've followed our Facebook page over the holiday break, you
 will have learned about several examples of how our students and staff led efforts to
 support our community during the holiday season, living by example our Monroe Public
 Schools core value to Act in Service for All. Examples include:
 - Mrs. Carol Anteau's PPI (Positive Peer Influence) class at MHS adopted a family for Christmas.
 - Darren Pocs, restorative justice coordinator at MHS, let a collection effort to adopt four families for Christmas.
