- <u>Summer Learning Academy</u>: There are 632 students enrolled in the Summer Learning Academy this year. For our seniors on track to graduate at the end of SLA, there will be a graduation ceremony on August 14 at 9:00 a.m. at MHS.
- Knabusch Math and Science Center Survivor Kids Camp: This summer, from June 24 through August 2, 230 students are taking part in Survivor Kids Day Camp. This camp engages students in learning outdoor survival skills such as shelter building, fishing, boating, archery, campfire cooking, plant and animal identification, and much more!
